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COURSE OVERVIEW:

A title or corner office does not make a leader. Spiritual leaders must be godly men and women called of God, equipped to serve, and committed to stewarding God's Kingdom plans.

Christian leaders are filled and directed by the Holy Spirit, steadfast in the face of opposition. and unrelenting in the midst of spiritual inertia. Spiritual leadership is moving

people on to God's agenda. How does a spiritual leader fulfill the call to move people on to God's agenda? This online Bible course will explore Jesus' model of spiritual leadership and how to follow it.

EVALUATION CRITERIA
